Sportsmanship Contract

The Moline Soccer Club/Moline United recognizes sportsmanship as an invaluable asset in soccer and in life. We need coaches, parents, referees and spectators to be solid role models at all matches, practices and any related MSC activities. Therefore, we are requesting all coaches, players, and parents to read and acknowledge the following:

1. Adhere to all guidelines set forth in the Moline Soccer Club, ILLOWA League, IYSA, and FIFA rulebooks.
2. Applaud during the introduction of players, coaches and officials.
3. Accept ALL decisions of officials. No booing or heckling!
4. Do not indulge in name-calling or use disrespectful, derogatory yells or chants.
5. Treat competition as a game, not a war.
6. Refrain from responding to opposing teams spectators' negative comments. "They started it by saying negative things towards us and our kids!" This will not help the situation. It will only elevate the animosity.
7. Applaud at the end of all games for participants, as they shake hands with each other, regardless of the contest outcome.
8. Show concern for injured players regardless of team affiliation.
9. Encourage people around you to display proper sportsmanlike conduct.
10. Refrain from displays of anger or use of profanity during a game.
11. Refrain from blaming the loss of contest on officials, coaches, or participants. Leave with positive attitude.
12. Refrain from approaching coaches with issues and/or complaints on game days, especially when you are upset. Call coach and make an appointment for another day. This will always produce a better outcome.
13. Show appreciation and encouragement for coaches and players, especially after lost contests.
14. Do not come to any MSC event under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Furthermore, do not ever consume alcohol and/or drugs on MSC premises. Note: this is a horrible example for your child and will only lead to embarrassment and frustration, as well as being ejected from the premises.
15. Do not coach or give direction during any game or practice. This undermines the objectives of the coaches and embarrasses your child.
16. When approached by a Field Marshall, MSC Board Member or MSC representative, please listen and be cooperative. Do not become confrontational or non-cooperative.

***If any of these expectations are not met at any time, you may be banned from future events and may jeopardize your child's status on his/her team.
